### **BIO**

Dr. Carmen Rodriguez is an obstetrician-gynecologist who practices at Long Island Jewish Medical Center (LIJMC). She obtained her medical degree in 1992, from Stony Brook Medical School, after completing the Sophie Davis School of Biomedical Education Program in NYC. She is a clinical assistant professor at the Donald and Barbara Zucker School of Medicine at Hofstra/Northwell. Dr. Rodriguez is the faculty advisor for the Zucker School of Medicine chapter of the Gold Humanism Honor Society.

Dr. Rodriguez is a preceptor for The Donald and Barbara Zucker School of Medicine students through the ICE (Initial Clinical Experience) Program. She has served as a preceptor to the Graduate Nursing and Physician Assistant Program, as well. In addition, she is a mentor to students at the Zucker School of Medicine through the URM Mentorship Program (Underrepresented Minority)

She has mentored college students, medical students and OBGYN residents throughout her career.

Dr. Rodriguez is a member of the LIJMC -OBGYN department Performance Improvement Coordinating Group (PICG) as well as a member of the Labor and Delivery Leadership Committee and the MoM's Best Practice Workgroup (Maternal Outcomes Navigation Program). In addition, she is a member of the Develop sub-committee of the Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Program at LIJMC.

She serves as a member at large of the board of The Nassau County Medical Society,
